Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Henry P. Willimon in the State aforesaid.
in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Twenty-five & 00/100-----(\$325.00)-----DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Louise Edwards Hayes, her heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of Conestee as shown by a Plat thereof, made by Madison H. Woodard, Engineer; said Lot having the courses distances, metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin joint corners of Lots No. 1 and 2 and running thence along the line of said Lot No. 2, N. 47-46 W. 200 feet to iron pin; thence N. 42-40 E. 60 feet to iron pin; thence S. 46-15 E. 225 feet to iron pin on Sixth Street; thence in a southwesterly direction at an angle 37.3 feet to an iron pin; still with Sixth Street, S. 42-14 W. 31.8 feet to point of beginning.

THAT the lands shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to any negro of person of African descent. No residence to cost less than Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars, shall be erected on said lot nearer than twenty-five (25) feet to the frontline, and no residence shall be built on any lot unless said lot has fifty (50) feet, or more, frontage.

GRANTEE to pay taxes for the year 1952.



TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
