Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, M. W. Fore
in consideration of the sum of Forty-seven and 50/100 (\$47.50) DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jacqueline Shelton, her Heirs and Assigns forever, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 30 on a Map of Fore Estates, near Greenville, South Carolina, made by Dalton & Neves, March, 1952, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book _____, page _____ and having, according to said Map the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Polk Boulevard, joint corner of lots Nos. 30 and 31, and running thence with line of Lot No. 31 S. 69-20 E. 180 feet to an iron pin; thence with rear line of lot No. 4 S. 20-40 W. 83 feet to an iron pin corner of lots 29 and 30; thence with line of Lot No. 29 N. 69-20 W. 180 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Polk Boulevard; thence with Polk Boulevard N. 20-40 E. 83 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

This property is conveyed subject to the following restrictions and conditions:

- (1) Property shall be used for Residential purposes only.
- (2) No residence shall be erected on said lot costing less than \$7500.00
- (3) No building shall be erected nearer than forty (40) feet from the front line.
- (4) No outside toilet to be permitted and sewage to be disposed of by approved septic tanks.
- (5) Property is not to be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to any Negro or person of African decent.

GRANTEE to pay 1952 taxes.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
