

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises aforementioned unto the said D. E. Galway, his heirs and assigns forever, together with the appurtenances thereunto or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all of the right, title, interest and claim whatsoever thereto belonging or to be held by the South Carolina State Highway Department.

In accepting this instrument, however, the grantee agrees that at such time as he shall fill the ravine or gully situate upon the above described strip of land, he will take such measures as shall be necessary to protect the drainage of the highway bed at this location, and that should any damage result from such filling, by virtue of any interference with the drainage of the highway bed, or adjacent properties, the grantee will save harmless and indemnify the South Carolina State Highway Department from any such loss or damage, or any liability resulting therefrom.
