All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, in the city of Greenville, on the north side of Croft Street, known and designated as the eastern half of lot No. 24, Section 1, on lot of property of the Stone Land Company recorded in plat book "A" page 537 of the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the north side of Croft Street, 271 feet and 10 inches from the east side of Robinson Street, and running thence with Croft Street S. 83-13 E. 54 feet 4 inches to a stake; thence N. 1-41 E. 108 feet to a stake; thence N. 93-13 W. 54 feet 4 inches to a stake; thence S. 1-41 W. 208 feet to the beginning corner.
