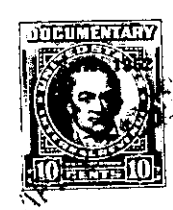

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ola D. Campbell all that piece, parcel and lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina; on the head waters of the North Tyger River, adjoining lands of D. W. Hodges, D. L. Burns and being part of the old Wm. Turner land and also being the identical tract of land conveyed to C. L. Burns by D. L. Burns, by deed dated April 8, 1926, recorded in Vol. 198, on page 217 in the office of REC for Greenville County, South Carolina, more particularly described as follows: BEGINNING on a stone, the South East corner of Wm. Turner land, and runs thence North 42 deg. east (va. 4 1/2 deg.) 145 feet to a stone; thence North 37 deg. East 627.8 feet to a stone; thence South 72 deg. 45 min east (va. 4 deg.) 833 feet to a stone at the place of a chestnut oak; thence North 28 deg. east (va. 4 deg.) 840 feet to a stone; thence north 54 deg. east (va. 4 1/2 deg.) 867 feet to a stone at place of vine; thence north 6 deg. West (va. 4 1/2 deg.) 463 feet to a stone at place of a dogwood; thence
