in consideration of the sum of FIVE HUNDRED and No/100 (\$500.00) DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Irving E. Lee and Sarah F. Lee, their Heirs and Assigns forever, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about four (4) miles West from the City of Greenville, known as the C. O. Berry property subdivision, made by H. S. Brockman, R. S., May 10-11, 1950, and being known and designated as lot No. 4 of said subdivision as shown on Plat recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "X", page 193, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Lily Street, joint corner of lots Nos. 4 and 5, and running thence with line of lot No. 5, S. 27-50 E. to an iron pin in branch, property now or formerly of Hugh Cureton; thence N. 58-18 E., 82.5 feet to an iron pin in branch; thence N. 44-48 E., 19.5 feet to an iron pin in branch, joint corner of lots Nos. 3 and 4; thence with line of lot No. 3, N. 27-50 W., 246.5 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Lily Street; thence with Lily Street, S. 62-10 W., 100 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
