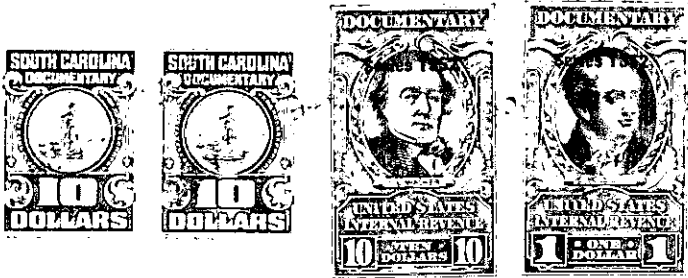

County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot no. 7 of
the property of F. H. Earle, as shown on plat thereof prepared by
Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, February 26, 1951, recorded in plat
book Z page 191 of the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and
having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-
wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Mills Avenue, the
