NOW, THEREFORE, We, C. E. Morgan, Individually and as Trustee; C. E. Hatch, Ruth E. Burnett, Ruth B. Pamplin and J. W. Burnett, Jr., as Heirs at Law of J. W. Burnett, deceased; William L. Lowndes, Jr.; James M. Davenport and South Carolina National Bank, as Trustees of the Estate of J. T. Davenport, deceased, as beneficiaries of the trust heretofore imposed in C. E. Morgan, and Ruby H. Kennemore, as purchaser and owner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2 as shown on Plat of the Property of Loddard and McPherson, do for value received, to us in hand paid (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), hereby release and forever discharge unto Charles G. Mason:

"Lots Nos. 10 and 11 as shown on Plat of Wade Cotman Property, recorded in Plat Book H at Page 163, and described by metes and bounds in the deed recorded in Book of Deeds 210 at Page 79,"

from any and all restrictions imposed for our benefit, and limiting the use of said lots for residential purposes. Further, by the execution of this agreement, we, the undersigned Trustees, and beneficiaries of said trust, do hereby agree and consent that Charles G. Mason, and/or his Heirs and Assigns, shall use the said lots for business purposes to the same extent as though the building restrictions hereinabove referred to had never been imposed for our benefit, and we do hereby waive any right to object to said use at any time in the future.

Inasmuch as C. E. Morgan, as Trustee, heretofore in our behalf imposed said restrictions, we do hereby authorize him as Trustee to join in the execution of this release.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all the aforementioned lots unto the said Charles G. Mason, his Heirs and Assigns, free from all limitations and restrictions.
