Barnett all that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Greenville, Glassy Mountain township, beginning at a stone on T.H. Reids line, running thence with Gowansville and Glassy Mountain road N.W. to John Barnetts corner, thence N.W. to a stone on top of the ridge in the field on L.P. Barnetts line, Thence West with said line to post oak at corner T.H. Reids line, Thence S.W. to a Spanish Oak, Thence S.E. to a stone on Evans corner, Thence S.E. to a White Oak, Thence with Evans line to the beginning corner. This being the tract of land deeded my wife Mary E. Barton by James Barnett, October 1, 1889.
