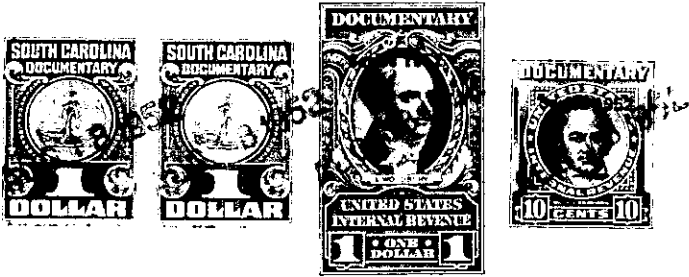

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. L. Hudson

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as tract No. 3
as shown on a plat made by H. S. Brockman, Reg. Land Surveyor,
dated September 27, 1951 and being described as a whole by courses
and distances as follows:

Beginning in center of road N. 84-15 W.
251 feet from corner of tracts No. 1 and 2 of said plat and running
thence N. 17-30 W. 530 feet to iron pin; thence N. 84-15 W. 298
feet to a stone on lands of T. K. Verdin, Jr.; thence S. 6-00 W.
442 feet to corner in the Greenville Road; thence along that road
S. 79-95 E. 513 feet to beginning corner in center of road, and
