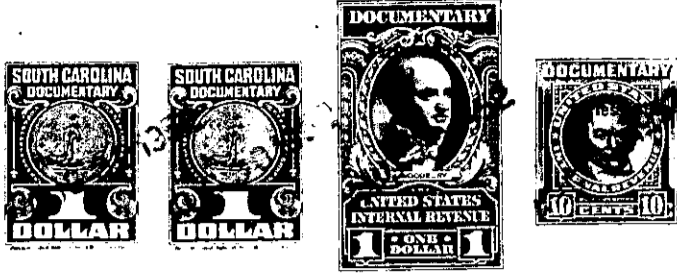

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Harvie and Varnell H Stewart

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, lying North of Grove Station, and being  
known and designated as lots numbers One- Two- and Seventeen  
on Plat of the W.M.Guest and I.N.Moody property, recorded in  
Plat Book S at page 187, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville  
County, having the following courses and distances to wit ;

BEGINNING on Moody Avenue at Joint corners of Lots Nos. 16  
and 17 and running thence along Moody Avenue 4-27- E to a point  
thence S-36-18-W 151 feet to joint corner of lots nos. 17 and  
1 ; thence S-69-00-W 138 feet and 9 inches to a point on Guest  
Avenue ; thence N-24-24-W 190 feet to joint corner of lots Nos.  
2 and 3, thence along line of lot number 3 152 feet to joint  
corners of lots nos. 2-3-16- and 17 ; thence along the line of
