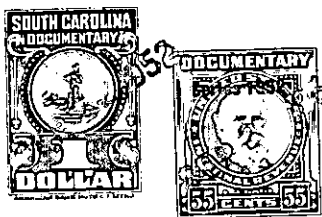

H. Cowart, by the Piedmont and Northern Railway Company, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby fully release and forever discharge the said Piedmont and Northern Railway Company, its successors and assigns from any and all claims, demands, actions or rights of action of every nature whatsoever, now existing or hereafter to arise by reason of surface water from the right-of-way and fill of said Piedmont and Northern Railway Company running down, upon and over and depositing dirt, rock or other debris upon the premises owned by the said J. H. Cowart and lying, situate and being on the Southwest side of said Piedmont and Northern Railway Company's track, just south of Piedmont, in the County and State aforesaid.

This paper writing contains the full and entire agreement between me and said company, and no promise has been made me of any other or further payment, consideration, or satisfaction of any nature whatsoever for the execution of this release or on account of the acts and things hereinbefore recited.

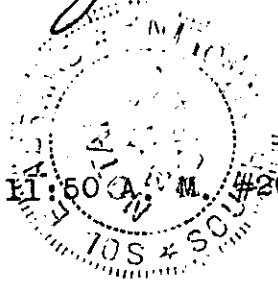
