

3. Lawrence H. Grogan is trustee for the use and benefit of the textile employees of the Woodside Mill plant located in Greenville, S. C., to hold the property formerly belonging to the Woodside TWUA Realty Corporation and TWUA Local No. 268 in trust for the use and benefit of said employees.

4. Lawrence H. Grogan is to continue to hold title to said real and personal property heretofore transferred and conveyed to him by Woodside TWUA Realty Corporation and TWUA Local No. 268 for the purposes set out herein.

5. Lawrence H. Grogan will undertake to the best of his ability to manage and protect said real and personal property, keeping it in good repair, and will do his best to see that adequate insurance coverage is maintained and that proper taxes are paid thereon.

6. Lawrence H. Grogan will hold said property, both real and personal, for the use and benefit of the textile employees working at the Woodside Mill plant located in Greenville, S. C. upon reasonable terms and conditions and for reasonable purposes designed to further trade unionism, and in all matters respecting the use and protection and disposal of said property will follow the dictates of an Advisory Board composed of the following five (5) men who are at present textile employees of said Woodside Mill plant located in Greenville, S. C. Said trust shall be for the use and benefit of only those persons who are now and in the future shall be and/or remain employees of said textile mill.

Decisions of said Advisory Board shall be by a majority vote of the members thereof voting on any question and said Board shall be composed of the following five (5) employees of the Woodside Mill plant located in Greenville, S. C.: S. L. Simmons, E. Ray Finley, T. A. Tollison, Harvey Rousey and Mark Garrison. Said Board is hereby empowered to adopt such rules and regulations as it may see fit to control its activities, voting procedure, notice of meetings, waiver of notice of meetings, etc.
