hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Waco F. Childers, Jr.,
his heirs and assigns:-----

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate; lying and being
in Butler Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as
Lot No. 33 on the Plat of College Heights made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers,
recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book
"P", page 75, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds,
courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Princeton Avenue
at the joint front corners of Lots 32 and 33, and running thence
N33-10W 150' to an iron pin; Thence S56-50W 75' to an iron pin;
Thence S33-10E 150' to an iron pin on Princeton Avenue; Thence
with Princeton Avenue N56-50E 75' to the beginning corner.

Victory Textiles (now McCall Manufacturing Company) by deed of Modern Industries
