All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, within the limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina lying and being on the north-side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue and being known and designated as Lot No. 26, according to plat of Pleasant Valley prepared by Dalton & Neves in April, 1946 as revised in May, 1948, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said county and state in Plat Book P, at page 93 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos, 25 and 26 said pin being 755 feet southwest of the iron pin on the northern side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue in the northwestern corner of the intersection of Pleasant Ridge Avenue with Long Hill Street and running thence N. 0-08 W. 160 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 25; thence S. 89-52 W. 60 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 27; thence along the line of Lot No. 27 S. 0-08 E. 160 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue; thence along Pleasant Ridge Avenue N. 89-52 E. 60 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning.

This property is subject to restrictive covenants of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 301, at page 60.

Also that electric hot water heater and space heater and Venetian blinds now being used in the dwelling.

It is understood that this property is subject to a mortgage executed to C. Douglas Wilson and Company, recorded in R. M. C. Office in book of Mortgages 441 page 431 in the original amount of \$7500.00 on which there is a balance due of \$6532.61. Grantee is to pay 1952 taxes.

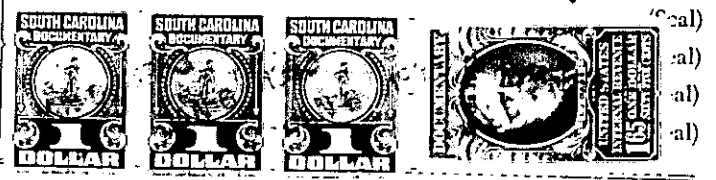
