That I, Roy waters OLLIE FARNSWORTH R.M.C. in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten Thousand, Two Hundred Fifty and 10/100 - - - - - DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Samuel D. Bright, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the northwest side of Durley Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot 27 on plat of Pickwick Heights, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, March 1950, recorded in the R. F. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book X, Page 141, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwest side of Durley Avenue, at joint front corner of Lots 27 and 28 and running thence with the line of Lot 27, N. 24-55 W. 131.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 85-27 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 24-53 E. 131.5 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of Durley Avenue; thence with the northwest side of Durley Avenue N. 24-55 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described property is a portion of the same conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Lillian C. Farnsworth, dated December 10, 1947, recorded in the R. F. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 407, Page 117, and by deed of E. Inman, Master, dated February 24, 1948, recorded in the R. F. C. Office in Deed Book 403, at Page 131.

For restrictions applicable to Pickwick Heights, see Deed Book 407, Page 117. Grantee to pay 1953 taxes.

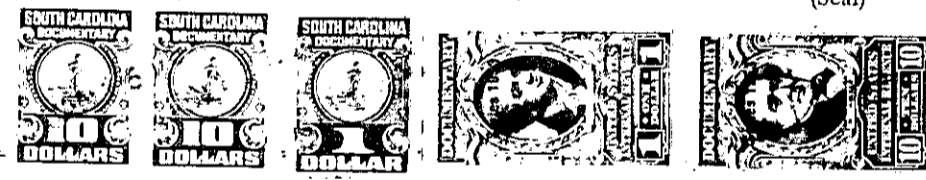
TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
