February A. D. 1953 file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they
were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Char-
itable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain
to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property, and that three days'
notice in the Greenville Evening News a newspaper published in the
County of Greenville has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is
THE MONROE PARKER EVANGELISTIC ASSOCIATION

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is Greenville, S. C.
(115 Trade Bldg.)

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to recruit, train, support and promote evangelism among evangelists, groups and individuals
and whenever feasible bring together for cooperative evangelistic campaigns
and assist them in securing same, zealous, capable, educated, spirit-filled
evangelists.

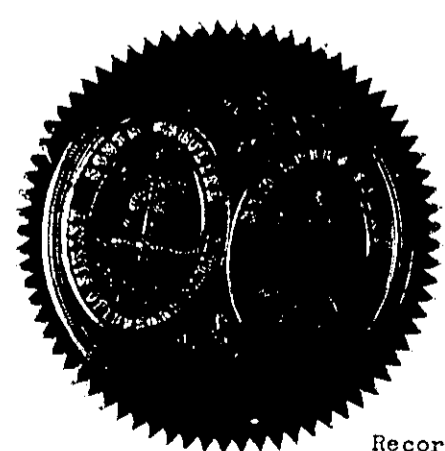

a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities,
conferred by said Chapter 158, Article III, Sections 8158-8159 and 8168, Code of 1942, and Acts amendatory thereto
