to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James Ralph Rochester and Melba Hughoy Rochester, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All those lots of land situate on the North side of U.S. Highway-Alternate Route No. 13 leading from Greenville toasley, S. C., near Saluda River, in Greenville Township, Greenville County, S. C., shown as Lot 11 on List of Property of L. A. Whitfire Estate, also by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, August 1919, recorded in the R.L.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in List Book "Y", page 37; and having according to said list the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of U.S. Highway-Alternate Route No. 13, at joint front corner of Lots 10 & 11 and running thence along line of Lot 10 N. 3-11W. 200 feet to an iron pin on the South side of a 25 foot alley; thence along the South side of said alley S. 05-10W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence along line of Lot 12, S. 0-11- E. 200 feet to an iron pin on the North side of U. S. Highway-Alternate Route No. 13; thence along the North side of said highway, N. 05-10 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is conveyed subject to the following restriction:

No tourist home or tourist cabins shall ever be operated on the above described lot.

This lot is a portion of a tract of land conveyed to L. A. Whitfire by A. C. Whitfire by deed dated March 17, 1917, recorded in the R.L.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 11, page 22. Thereafter, L. A. Whitfire died testate, December 27, 1947, leaving his last will and testament on file in the Office of Probate Court, Greenville County, S. C., at Court #42, File 25, and under said will he devised the above property to the grantor, Mary Sue Whitfire, for her life, and at her death, to his daughter, the grantor, Mary Sue Whitfire (now Mary Sue Whitfire Peterson).
