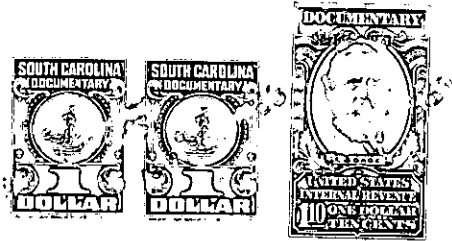
That We, George D. Williams and Nora Louise J. Williams
