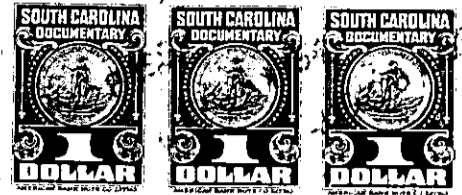

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Frank M. Shockley, his heirs and assigns forever,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, being known and designated as Tracts Nos. 2 and 3A of property of the P.T. Shockley Estate as shown on plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, July 1949 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "O", at page 184, containing 9.18 acres, more or less and having together the following metes and bounds according to said plat:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the Old Conestee Road, corner of E. B. Hendrix Estate and running thence with Hendrix line, South 33-15 West 989.7 feet to stake in the Fork Shoals Road; thence with Fork Shoals Road, South 36-0 East 166 feet to stake at corner of Tract 3B; thence with line of Tract 3B, North 53-30 East 589.3 feet to stake; thence with rear line of Tract 3B, South 54-15 East 126.8 feet to stake, joint corner of Tracts Nos. 1, 2, 3B and 4; thence with line of Tract No. 1 North 33-15 East 538 feet to stake on Old Conestee Road; and thence with said Road, North 60-30 West 514 feet to the beginning corner.

This being the same property conveyed to E. C. Shockley by A. D. Shockley, et al by deed dated Nov. 12, 1949 and recorded in Deed Book 396, at page 29, RMC Office for Greenville County.
