DOLLARS, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Winfred Anderson

All our right, title and interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the state of South Carolina, county of Greenville, city of Greenville, situate at the southeast corner of Nichols Street and Green Avenue, and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of Green Avenue and Nichols Street and running thence with the south side of Nichols Street 98 feet, more or less, to corner of lot now or formerly owned by Edward Anderson; thence with the line of the Anderson lot 68 feet, more or less, corner of lot formerly conveyed to Winfred Anderson; thence along line of Winfred Anderson lot 83 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the west side of Green Avenue; thence with Green Avenue 79.2 feet, more or less to the beginning corner, said premises being all of the lot conveyed to W.L.
