All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Southerly side of the Double Springs Church Road, leading to Milford Church, containing six (6) acres more or less, designated as Tract No. 4 on Map No. 3 of the property of W. R. C. Edwards Estate, according to a survey made by H. L. Donahoo, dated September 24, 1946, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds to-wit:
