I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, W. H. Corbett and Waddell A. Corbett,

on or about the 25th day of April in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty exhibited their
complaint in the ^{County} Court ~~of Common Pleas~~, for the County aforesaid, against Toy P. Farmer,
H. A. Dill, Bessie Aiken, et al,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to
be heard on the 6th day of May 1953,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Toy P. Farmer and H. A. Dill
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$900.00.

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Toy P. Farmer and H. A. Dill
Tract #1:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and
being on the South Pacolet River in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, designated as the M. L. Gosnell Reserva-
tion on a plat of property of W. H. and W. A. Corbett and Toy P. Farmer
and H. A. Dill, the same being prepared by W. P. Morrow and H. B. Franken-
field, Jr., September, 1951, and having according thereto the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of said South Pacolet River, the
same being located by a marked Locust Tree on the Northern bank of said
river, and running thence up said river S. 13-30 E. 3.55 chains to a point
in the Western side of said river; thence S. 84-00 W. 7.5 chains to a
point; thence N. 32-00 W. 3.8 chains to a point; thence N. 58-00 W. 5.32
chains to a point; thence N. 31-00 W. 6.61 chains to a stake at a Black-
gum; thence N. 10-38 W. 4.76 chains to a Pine; thence N. 45-30 E. 10
chains to a stake; thence N. 85-30 E. 3 chains to a stake; thence S. 23-30
E. 21 chains to the point of beginning, said tract containing 26.1 acres,
more or less.
