

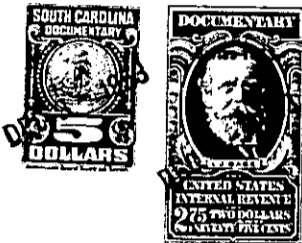

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. C. LYNCH, HIS HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, in the State of South Carolina, said lot being situated on the north side of Branch, and BEGINNING on a stake in Branch on the south side of new road; thence along the south side of road S. 66-05 E. 235 feet to a bend; thence S. 44-28 E. 200 feet to a bend; thence S. 27-50 E. 300 feet to a bend; thence S. 35-01 E. 300 feet to a bend; thence S. 22-15 E. 200 feet to a bend; thence S. 31-03 E. 200 feet to a bend; thence 47-38 E. 200 feet to a bend; thence S. 61-05 E. 200 feet to a bend; thence S. 37-21 E. 35 feet to a stake on side of road; thence S. 29 N. 311 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 85-45 W. 515 feet to an iron pin in the Branch; thence down the Branch 345 feet, more or less, to a stake; thence down the Branch 1023 feet, more or less to a stake; thence down the Branch 310 feet, more or less, to the BEGINNING corner, containing 16.40 acres, more or less.
