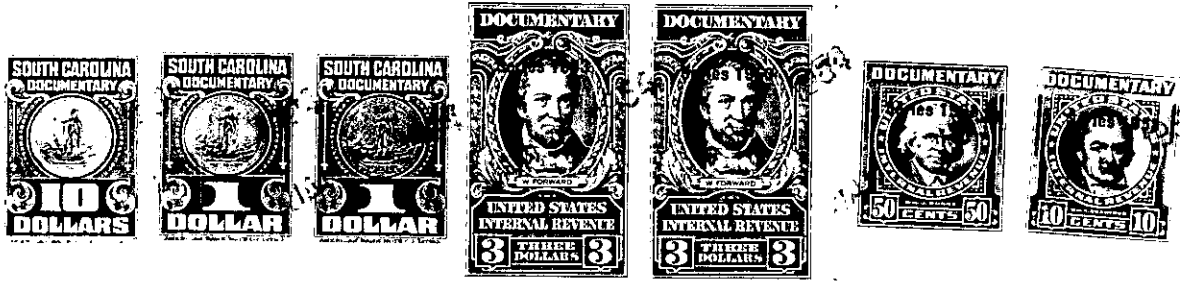

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. N. E. Dowling, her heirs,
and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina on the Southern side of Hampton Avenue, in the
city of Greenville, being shown as lots Nos. 26 and 28, Section 1,
Page 24 in the City Block Book, and being more particularly described
by metes and bounds, as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern side of Hampton Avenue on the
corner of lot formerly owned by J. J. McSwain, and running thence with
the line of said lot, S. 55 W. 226 feet to an iron pin; thence in a
Southeasterly direction, 60 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 55 E. 12
feet to a stake; thence in a Northwesterly direction, 4.2 feet to a
stake; thence N. 55 E. 209.8 feet to an iron pin on Hampton Avenue;
thence with the Southern side of Hampton Avenue, N. 35 W. 50 feet to
the point of beginning.
