

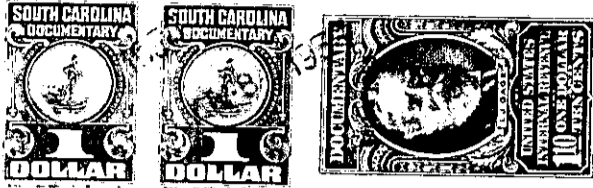

and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred - - - - - Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto Frank E. Lollis his Heirs and Assigns forever:

All that piece parcel or lot of land lying, being and situate in the County and State aforesaid, Fairview Township, containing one acre, more or less, with the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in Public Road, on line of land now or formerly of Harrison and W. B. Thomason, and running thence along said road S. 30 E. 210 feet to an iron pin insaid road; thence S. 67-20 W. 210 feet to a stake; thence N. 30 W. 210 feet to stake on line of colored church property; thence along said line N. 67-20 E. 210 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same property conveyed to Fairview School District No. 3 D by deed of W. B. Thomason August 16, 1934 of record in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 178, Page 347.
