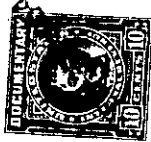

Know All Men by These Presents:

That We, T. Frank Huguenin and John T. Douglas, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seventy Seven Hundred Fifty & No/100 (\$7750.00) - - - DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas W. Miller, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Tract No. 3, as shown on a plat of the property of Parkins Lake Development, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Registered Engineers, in January, 1954, to be recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of the Parkins Mill Road, at its intersection with Cleveland Street Extension, and running thence S. 62-20 W. 72.7 feet to an iron pin in the center of the Parkins Mill Road; thence S. 18-26 W. 72.3 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Parkins Lake Road; thence along the Eastern side of the said Parkins Lake Road, S. 25-27 E. 700 feet across a branch to an iron pin; thence N. 39-34 E. 158 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 65-30 E. 110.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 80-37 E. 157.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 69-43 E. 111.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 79-19 E. 77.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 73-36 E. 93.1 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corners of Tracts Nos. 2 and 4; thence N. 34-45 W. 818 feet to an iron pin in the center of the Parkins Mill Road; thence continuing along the center of the said Parkins Mill Road, S. 64-35 W. 410 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

BEING a part of the property conveyed to the grantors herein by R. C. Collins, by deed dated the 1st day of February, 1954, to be recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

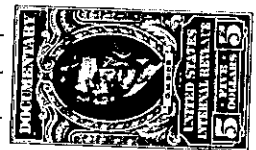
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises, before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.
