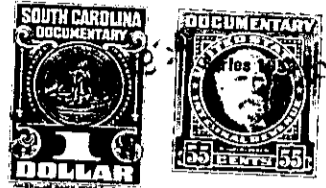

hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and

released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

George B. Cleveland and Mary K. Cleveland, their Heirs and Assigns forever, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot No. 240 on a Plat of Augusta Acres, property of Marsmen, Inc., recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "S", page 201, and having, according to said Plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Churchill Circle, joint corner of lots Nos. 239 and 240, and running thence with line of lot No. 239, N. 82-04 W., 191.5 feet to an iron pin; thence with rear line of lots Nos. 247, and 246, S. 9-10 W., 115 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots Nos. 240 and 241; thence with line of lot No. 241, S. 77-02 E., 188.5 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Churchill Circle; thence with Churchill Circle, N. 10-16 E., 131.1 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
