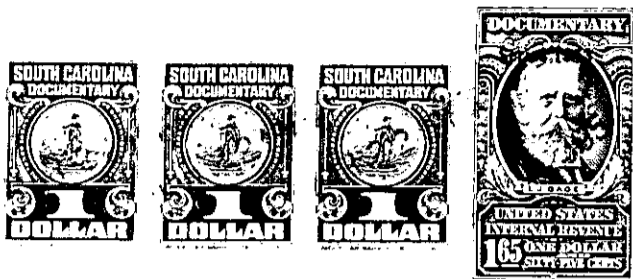

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That I, Calvin W. Worrill of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500.00) Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by A. S. Campbell, and Ellen W. Campbell (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. S. Campbell, and Ellen W. Campbell, their heirs, and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just off the New Buncombe Road, about three miles from the Greenville County Court House, and being described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin corner at the intersection of Razor Drive and Razor Drive Extension, and running thence along the South side of Razor Drive, N. 7 1/2 W. 127.5 feet to an iron pin corner on said Razor Drive; thence S. 20 W. 660 feet to an iron pin corner on Creek; thence along the creek bed S. 68 E. 91 feet to an iron pin corner; thence N. 25-27 E. 571 feet to an iron pin corner; thence N. 18-63 E. 110 feet to the point of beginning, containing a portion of Lots Nos. 23 and 24 as shown on original plat of said property recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book I at pages 69 and 70
