CORRECTION DEED to correct deed, R.M.C. office vol. 484, page 259. **Know All Men by These Presents:**

That I, Heyward L. Cooper, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of _____ DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George W. Cooper, his heirs and assigns forever,

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land lying and situate in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying North of Grove Station, being known and designated as part of lot # 24 on a plat of the William Guest and I. N. Moody property recorded in R. M. C. Office in Plat Book S at page 187, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on an unnamed road, said point being the joint corner of lots 24 and 25; thence running along said road, N. 34-45 W. 100 feet, to a point approximately the middle of the joint line of lot # 24; thence N. 56-30 E. approximately 210 plus additional feet more or less to a point on the back line of lot # 24; thence in a Southeastern direction along the back line of lot # 24 to the joint back corner of lots 24 and 25; thence along the joint line of lots 24 and 25 S. 56-30 W. 210 feet to the beginning corner.

This being part of lot # 24, but not including that part of the whole lot heretofore conveyed to me by George W. Cooper by deed dated February 21, 1952 and recorded in R. M. C. Office Vol. 451, page 541, Greenville County, South Carolina. This being the same portion of said whole lot conveyed to me by later deed by George W. Cooper and described as "the residue and remainder" of the whole lot, said deed being dated August 8, 1952 and recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office Vol. 465, page 285.

This deed is to correct a deed recorded in Vol. 484, page 259.
