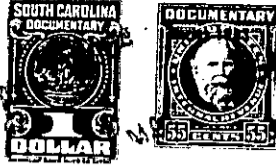

Know All Men by These Presents:

That We, E. M. Bishop and Rosa Lee Bishop

in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Twenty-Five and No/100 - (\$425.00) - - - DOLLARS, in the State aforesaid, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James P. Kay, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that lot of land situate on the east side of Rose Circle, (shown on plat hereinafter referred to as unnamed 36 foot road), in Austin Township, in Greenville County, S. C., near the road running from Mauldin to Conestee and being shown as Lot No. 17 on plat of property of E. M. and Rosa Lee Bishop, made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, August 1938, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "S", at Page 127, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Rose Circle, at joint front corner of Lots 15 and 17 and running thence with the line of Lot 15, S. 87-30 E. 201.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 2-00 W. 99.8 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 19, N. 87-30 W. 207 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Rose Circle; thence along the east side of Rose Circle, N. 5-10 E. 99.9 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the grantors herein by deed of Margaret Charles Gilreath, dated November 1, 1947, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 325, at Page 359.

Grantee to pay 1954 taxes.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
