

3. BUYER agrees to pay SELLER cash on delivery for all gasoline and other products sold hereunder, and BUYER further agrees to pay SELLER for all gasoline so purchased at SELLER's posted tank wagon price current at the time of delivery, which price will at all times be filed at SELLER's principal office at Greenville, S. C.

With respect to other products sold hereunder, the following prices shall prevail:

Tankwagon price on Motor Oils and Lubricants.

4. BUYER agrees that if during the term of this Agreement it intends to resell any of the gasoline herein purchased at a retail price which is less than 4 cents (4¢) above SELLER's then current posted tank wagon price, it will give SELLER a minimum of seventy-two (72) hours notice before putting such price reduction into effect.

5. As part of the consideration of this Agreement, SELLER agrees to loan BUYER, the following equipment, hereinafter referred to as "loaned equipment", under the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth:

- 3 - Electric Computer Pumps
- 2 - 1000 Underground tanks
- 1 - 550 Underground tank
- 1 - $\frac{1}{2}$ hp. Air Compressor
- 2 - Island Lights
- 1 - # 36 Road Sign.

6. It is agreed between the parties that the loaned equipment at all times is the sole property of SELLER and that BUYER has no interest in same regardless of whatever use BUYER might make of same.

7. It is agreed between the parties that at any time SELLER may substitute or replace any loaned equipment regardless of the grade or condition of the equipment so substituted or replaced without the consent of BUYER.

8. BUYER agrees to permit SELLER to enter upon its premises at any reasonable time for purpose of inspecting, maintaining, repairing, replacing or substituting said loaned equipment, the cost of which shall be borne by SELLER, when done by SELLER.
