REVOCATION OF POWER OF ATTORNEY

WHEREAS, the undersigned, Reconstruction Finance Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "RFC"), a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of an Act of Congress entitled "Reconstruction Finance Corporation Act", did on the 9th day of June, 1953, by a certain instrument make, constitute, and appoint FRED H. FOY, OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, COUNTY OF FULTON, STATE OF GEORGIA, its true and lawful attorney for it and in its name and stead to exercise certain powers of attorney granted to said FRED H. FOY by said instrument; and,

WHEREAS, RFC desires to revoke, as of this date, the powers given to said FRED H. FOY under the above described instrument, or otherwise, without affecting or impairing in any way any act heretofore lawfully done by him thereunder;

NOW, THEREFORE, RFC does hereby revoke, terminate, and make null and void, as of this date, all the powers and authorities given under and by said power of attorney, and by any other power of attorney, to said FRED H. FOY; provided that this revocation shall not prejudice or affect anything lawfully done or caused to be done by said FRED H. FOY in the exercise of any of the powers contained in said power of attorney between the date thereof and the date of this revocation.
