That We, W. W. Wilkins and G. Dewey Oxner, in consideration of the sum of --Two Hundred Seventy-five (\$275.00)----- in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Harold H. Martin, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or strip of land in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being a small portion of Lot No. 18 shown on plat of Carver Court made by Piedmont Engineering Service, March, 1955, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book I I, page 107, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Elder Street, joint front corner of Lots 17 and 18 and running thence along the line of Lot 17 S. 49-40 E. 144.7 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lot 18 S. 52-31 W. 6.5 feet to a point; thence with a new line through Lot 18 N. 60-24 W. 140.8 feet to a point on Elder Street; thence along Elder Street N. 17-34 E. 6.5 feet to the beginning corner.

The foregoing constitutes a small strip of land cut from the northeastern side of Lot No. 18.

The property above described is conveyed subject to the covenants and restrictions recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 526, page 297, which are made a part hereof as fully as if set out herein, and to the public utility easement granted to the Duke Power Company dated September 1, 1955, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 536, page 484.

The property herein conveyed constitutes a portion of the property conveyed to us by Jessie D. Webster by deed dated September 28, 1954, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 509, page 122.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named and his Heirs and Assigns forever.
