Bramlett, and the property being conveyed and running thence N. 50-28 E. 105 feet to an iron pin in Brushy Creek; thence with Brushy Creek S. 20-39 E. 107.8 feet to an iron pin in Brushy Creek; thence N. 68-08 E. 13 feet to an iron pin in Brushy Creek; thence S. 22-07 E. 47.9 feet to an iron pin in the right of way line of the Southern Railroad; thence with the right of way line of said Railroad S. 60-52 W. 72.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 59-25 W. 139 feet more or less to an iron pin on Anderson Road, the point of beginning."
