TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, privileges, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Clarence Beachem, Richard Simmons, Louie Johnson, Henry Williams and Clinton Jackson, TRUSTEES OF BETHEL METHODIST CHURCH, their successors and assigns, forever.

IN TRUST, that said premises shall be used, kept, and maintained as a place of divine worship of the Methodist ministry and members of The Methodist Church; subject to the Discipline, usage, and ministerial appointments of said church as from time to time authorized and declared by the General Conference and by the Annual Conference within whose bounds the said premises are situated. This provision is solely for the benefit of the Grantees, and the Grantor reserves no right or interest in said premises.
