

We do further grant to Georgia Pacific Corporation the right to cut, use and/or remove underground, brush, earth or stones, the cutting, removal or use of which may be necessary or convenient to the cutting and removal of said timber and timber products. Said Corporation is given the full right to remove all machinery, fixtures and other things of whatsoever nature which it may place upon the premises, and it shall not be prohibited to remove road beds, bridges, rails, timber or stones, and shall not be precluded from doing so if it so desires.

The Georgia Pacific Corporation, its successors and assigns, shall have the full term of two (2) years after the date heretofore written which to remove the timber, after cutting, to use and exercise the rights, privileges and easements above granted. In the event some major disaster should occur during said two (2) year period, the Grantors agree to give Grantee a reasonable extension of time in which to remove same. Said timber and exercise all the rights, privileges, etc., herein granted, shall be so much of said timber and trees as remains on said land, either standing or fallen, at the expiration thereof, shall immediately revert to and become the property of the Grantors, its successors and assigns, to the extent of its interest in said property.

TO LIVE AND TO HOLD unto the said Georgia Pacific Corporation, its successors and assigns, for the full term and period of time hereinabove specified for the cutting and removing of said timber and trees and for the enjoyment of all benefits.
