

to do further grant to Georgia Pacific Corporation the right to cut, use and/or remove underground, brush, earth or stone, the cutting, removal or use of which may be necessary or convenient to the cutting and removal of said timber and other products. Said Corporation is given the full right to remove all machinery, fixtures and other things of whatsoever nature which may place upon the premises, and it shall not be obligated to remove road beds, ditches, rails, stumps or stumps, and shall not be precluded from doing so in its business.

The Georgia Pacific Corporation, its successors or assigns, shall have the full term of two (2) years from the date hereof within which to remove the timber hereby conveyed, to use and exercise the rights, privileges and easements hereby granted. In the event some major disaster shall occur during said two (2) year period, the Grantee agrees to give a reasonable extension of time in which to remove said timber and exercise all the rights, privileges hereby granted. All the timber and trees as remain on said land, either standing or fallen, at the expiration hereof, shall immediately revert to and become the property of the Grantor, his successors and assigns, to the extent of their interest in said property.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said Georgia Pacific Corporation, its successors and assigns, for the full term and period of time hereinabove specified for the cutting and removing of said timber and trees and for the enjoyment of all benefits.

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
