KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That /as Agent for Furman University, a banking corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America,

in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand Nine Hundred and No/100 (\$5,900.00) ^{AUG 6} 5-20 P.M. 1958 dollars, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto JOSEPH E. BOYTER AND MARTHA D. BOYTER:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southeastern side of South Warwick Road, in Paris Mountain Township, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 82 of a subdivision known as Stratford Forest, and having according to a plat of said subdivision prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated February 25, 1957, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book KK at page 89, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of South Warwick Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 81 and 82, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 81 S. 30-00 E. 257.3 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 68 S. 73-15 W. 258.2 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 65; thence with the line of Lots Nos. 65 and 64, N. 15-45 W. 299.6 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of South Warwick Road; thence with the Southeastern side of South Warwick Road S. 88-40 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the Southeastern side of South Warwick Road N. 83-34 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to "Protective Covenants Applicable to Stratford Forest" recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 578 at page 1 and to drainage and utility easements, if any, affecting said lot.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Furman University, dated November 13, 1956, and recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 567 at page 397.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
