its successors and assigns, forever: ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being composed of two tracts of land, described as follows:

TRACT 1, located on the Southeastern side of the road leading from the Hendersonville-Greenville Highway to Saluda, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake in the center of the Saluda Road and running thence S.  $19\frac{1}{2}$  E., (passing an iron pin at 20 feet) 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N.  $74\frac{1}{2}$  E., 120 feet to an iron pin; thence N.  $19\frac{1}{2}$  W., 100 feet to a stake in the center of the said Saluda Road; thence along the center of the line of said Saluda Road, 120 feet to the beginning.
