

BEGINNING at a point on the eastern side of Lois Avenue (formerly Woodside Avenue), and running thence with Southern Railway's right-of-way N. 59-50 E. 111.5 feet to a point on the western side of Woodside Avenue (formerly old location of Woodside Avenue); thence with the western side of Woodside Avenue S. 19-00 E. 50 feet to a stake, corner of the lot described hereinabove; thence with the line of said lot S. 59-13 W. 100 feet to a stake on the eastern side of Lois Avenue; thence with the eastern side of Lois Avenue N. 32-29 W. 50 feet to the point of beginning.
