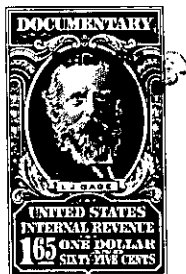

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Pleasantdale Circle, joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2 and running thence with the line of Lot 2, S. 32-50 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of property of James Leake, N. 57-10 E. 148.9 feet to an iron pin on Pleasantdale Circle; thence with said Pleasantdale Circle, N. 46-37 W. 180.9 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the curve of Pleasantdale Circle, the chord of which is North 84-43 W. 39.3 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said Pleasantdale Circle, S. 57-10 W. 79 ft. to an iron pin, point of Beginning.
