KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, Mrs. Lena

ceipt whereof being hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto

This option may be exercised by FOOD-LANE, INCORPORATED,
at any time before midnight on November 17, 1958; and, if it is
so exercised, then FOOD-LANE, INCORPORATED, is to have thirty
(30) days thereafter in which to have a title examination made
of same. If said option is so exercised, then, when called upon
by said corporation within said thirty-day period, I do hereby
agree to deliver to said corporation, in exchange for said pur-
chase price, a deed conveying to said corporation, its successors
and assigns, a good, marketable, fee simple, unencumbered title
to said property.

If said option is so exercised, then the above mentioned
Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars is to be a credit on the above
mentioned purchase price for said property. If this option is
so exercised, I am to have thirty (30) days from the date of the
delivery of said deed from me to FOOD-LANE, INCORPORATED, in
which to vacate said property, or as much of said thirty (30)
