in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John K. Temple, Jr., his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 45, according to a plat of Map No. 2 of Camilla Park, prepared by W. J. Riddle, December 1943 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M at Page 185, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
