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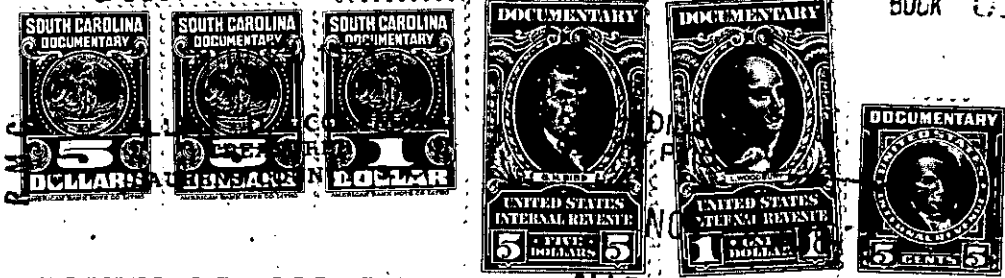

in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and
other valuable considerations

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these Presents, by CANAL WOOD CORPORATION, a South Carolina corporation, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said CANAL WOOD CORPORATION:

All of the merchantible timber, of every kind and description, both standing and fallen, of 4 inches and upward, the long way outside the bark, stump diameter 1 inches from the ground, now or at the time of cutting, also all of the timber, of every kind and description, both standing and fallen, of inches and upward, the long way outside the bark, stump diameter inches from the ground, now or at the time of cutting, on all and singular that

certain piece, parcel, or tract of land containing 21.4 acres, more or less, situate, lying and being in Dials Township, in the County of Laurens and in Fairview Township Greenville County in the State of South Carolina, and bounded and described as follows, to wit:

Tract No. 1. All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dials Township, Laurens County, State of South Carolina, containing Ninety (90) acres, more or less, bounded on the North by lands of Mrs. Hugh McCarter, on the East by the John Nash Place of Robert Franklin Chapman, on the South by lands of Claude Willis, on the Southwest by lands of Berry Woods, and on the West by the Polly Nash Place of Robert F.
