I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Missouri Jones, et al

on or about the 2nd day of December in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-eight exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Florence Barksdale

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 5th day of December, 1958, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Missouri Jones for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. H 3747)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Missouri Jones, her heirs and assigns forever

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Butler Township, known and designated as Tract No. 6 on plat of property of Richard H. Morton, according to a survey and plat made by C. O. Riddle, October, 1958:

Beginning at a point in a county road at the northwest corner of Tract No. 5 and running thence with line of Tract No. 5, S. 5-57 W. 1111.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 84-04 W. 333.2 feet to a pin, corner of Tract No. 7; thence with line of Lot No. 7, N. 5-57 E. 1160 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 87-38 E. 326.7 feet to the beginning corner, containing 8.50 acres, more or less.
