KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Nora Roe

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and Love and Affections Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Boyce T. Roe

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Boyce T. Roe and his Heirs and Assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina Lying on the south side of Mush Creek and containing Four Acres, more or less having the following Metes and Bounds:

Beginning at a White Oak ( dead) and running thence N.48-30 W. 5.50 chains to a stake on Mush Creek; thence up the meanders of said creek as property line to a stake; thence S. 6-30 E. E. 6.00 chains to a stake; thence N.61-45 E. 9.45 chains to beginning corner and bounded by lands D.T. Bailey, W.B.Taylor and others, being all of the same land conveyed to Nora Roe by David E. Bradley on 30th of May, 1934 and recorded in Book 167 Page 272 in R.M.C. Office of Greenville County

Also another Tract of land adjoining the above Tract and lying on both sides of Mush Creek and containing One Hundred Twenty Six Acres, more or less, however less one acre reserved for a family grave- yard and having the following Metes and Bounds:

Beginning at a Post Oak, 3x, and running thence S.30 W. 9.70 chains to three Willows on bank of Mush Creek; thence up Mush Creek as property line 37.65 chains to a stake, formerly J.M.Bailey's corner above; thence S. 48-40 E. 6.30 chains to a dead White Oak; thence N. 84 E. 30.80 chains to a Post Oak; thence N. 41-30 E. 15.40 to a Black Gum; thence down the meanders of a Branch as property line 16 chains to a stake; 3x; thence N. 60-15 W. 22.25 chains to a Hickory; thence N.87 W. 12.30 chains to the beginning corner.
