KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That DUKE POWER COMPANY, a New Jersey corporation, Grantor, in consideration of \$1.00 paid by PARKER WATER AND SEWER SUB-DISTRICT COMMISSION, a body politic organized under the laws of the State of South Carolina, Grantee, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does grant and convey unto Grantee a right of way in and over that tract of land in or near the City of Greenville, bounded on the West by the Piedmont and Northern Railway Company right of way, on the East and South by land now or formerly of Cotwool Manufacturing Corporation, being shown on print File No. 4-135, dated August 31, 1948, revised November 18, 1958, a copy of which is hereto attached, and being the land described in deed from Cotwool Manufacturing Corporation to Duke Power Company, dated October 25, 1948, recorded in the Public Registry of Greenville County in Book 363, page 315, the center line of said right of way hereby granted being shown by red line on the attached print and thereon indicated "Proposed Sewer Line"; said right of way to be 25 feet in width during the construction of the sewer line and 10 feet in width thereafter.

The right of way hereby granted is to Grantee, its successors and assigns, and is the right and privilege of entering the above described strip of land and of constructing, maintaining and operating within the limits of same, pipelines, manholes, and other adjuncts deemed necessary by Grantee for the purpose of conveying sanitary sewage and industrial wastes, and to make such relocations, changes, renewals, substitutions, replacements and additions of or to same within said strip of land from time to time as Grantee may deem desirable; with the right at all times to cut away
