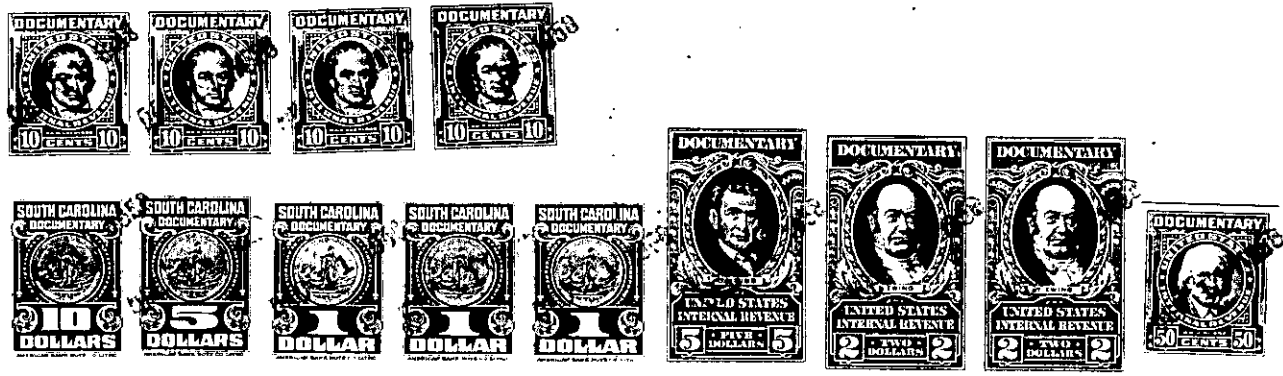

ROSS, JR. AND MARGARET P. ROSS:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 47 as shown on a plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated December 20, 1957, entitled "Green Valley Estates", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book QQ at pages 2 and 3, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Sweet Gum Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 46 and 47, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 46 S. 34-33 E. 210.8 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of the Golf Course N. 89-38 E. 180.3 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the line of the Golf Course N. 40-48 E. 94.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 47 and 48; thence with the line of Lot No. 48 N. 33-06 W. 299.7 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Sweet Gum Drive; thence with the Southeastern side of Sweet Gum Drive S. 52-26 W. 250 feet to the point of beginning.
