THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA : BILL of SALE

 COUNTY OF GREENVILLE : RENTAL AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, I, Lawrence E. Thompson, am in bad health and wish to sell all of the livestock on my farm, lease the farm, and retire; and,

WHEREAS, I, Esther Thompson, wish to buy said livestock and to lease the said farm, and operate the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, the said Lawrence E. Thompson, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Esther Thompson, have sold and transferred, and by these presents do sell and transfer, unto the said Esther Thompson, all of the livestock of every kind and description now on my farm hereinafter described, to be hers absolutely and forever.

AND I, the said Lawrence E. Thompson, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to me in hand paid by the said Esther Thompson, do hereby lease unto the said Esther Thompson my farm in Greenville County, South Carolina, situate about 12 miles northeast of the City of Greenville, and consisting of approximately 115 acres of land, this lease to commence with the date hereof and to run to and include December 31, 1959.

I, Esther Thompson, for value received, do hereby purchase the livestock aforesaid at the price above named, and do hereby lease the said farm, for the period herein specified, at the rental above stated.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunto placed our signatures and affixed our seals, binding ourselves, our personal representatives, heirs and assigns, to the faithful performance of this instrument, according to its true intent and meaning, firmly by these presents, this the 1st day of January, 1959.
